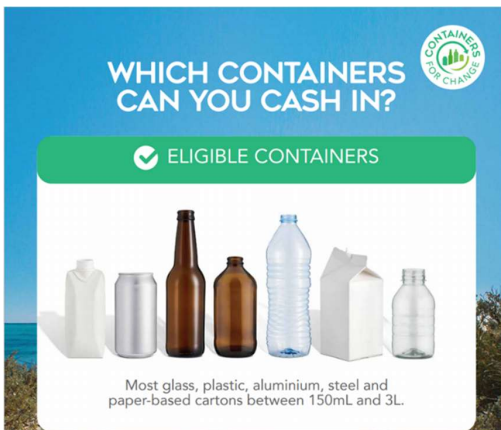
Dear Parents and Guardians,

From this term we will be joining the Containers for Change scheme. This scheme means our school will be able to receive 10c back for every eligible beverage container. As you collect containers within your household you may deposit them into the specified bins and help us to raise funds all while recycling and doing our part to help clean up WA.

Down Under Recycling Pty Ltd will provide the school with two bins specifically for collecting eligible containers. One of these will be located within the early learning center and one will be located next to the Year Six classrooms.

Please see eligible containers below:

ELIGIBLE CONTAINERS



Glass, plastic, steel and liquid paperboard containers between 150ml and 3 litres can be returned. You will receive a 10 cent refund for every eligible beverage container.

To be eligible the beverage container must:

- Have contained a beverage product that is not excluded from the scheme.
- Display the refund mark. This is so we can identify if the container is part of the scheme.
- Be an approved container. Some containers are made out of materials that cannot be recycled.

INELIGIBLE CONTAINERS

Beverage containers not eligible for a refund include those that are smaller than 150ml or larger than 3 litres.

Other exclusions include:

- Plain milk containers
- Glass containers that have carried wine or pure spirits
- Flavoured milk, fruit or vegetable juice and cask wine containers 1 litre or larger
- Concentrated/undiluted cordial or syrup containers
- Wine sachets 250ml or larger
- Registered health tonics
