Please join us to celebrate the beginning of Lent

The season of Lent in the church calendar is a season that calls us to a change of heart. It is a 'journey' of 40 days, calling us to look beyond ourselves to the needs of others, to "turn away from sin" (the things that distance us from God) and to use prayer, fasting and almsgiving to deepen our relationship with Him.

The forty-day Season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes on Holy Thursday evening with the Celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper. It is primarily the Church's time of preparation for the Easter mystery.

The ashes which will be used to mark a sign of the cross on our foreheads are made from the blessed palms used in the Palm Sunday celebration of the previous year. The ashes are christened with Holy Water and are scented by exposure to incense. While the ashes symbolise our sorrow for the times we have not lived as God wants us to, they are also a reminder that God is gracious and merciful and always ready to forgive and welcome those who turn to Him.

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Friends

The students are engaging and participating fully in the daily routines and activities. Currently classes from Year 1 to 6 are undertaking swimming lessons and they are to be commended for their excellent behaviour and attention to their instructors.

We are very pleased with the attendance at our Parent Information sessions yesterday evening. I encourage parents and caregivers to communicate frequently with class and specialist teachers concerning the progress of your child/ren. 

Children with Medical Requirements / Medic Alerts

St Munchin's requires a medical form to be completed for **all children** who need to take any form of medication or have a medical condition of which the school staff needs to be made aware. If you have kept medication in the office from last year, please call in to check the expiry date. It is important that if your child requires medication, particularly over Weeks 3 and 4 with swimming lessons, that this medication is handed in to the class teacher or the office.

School Fees

Accounts detailing 2019 school fees has been sent home with your child. You may call in to the office to pay your account annually or over three terms by cash or cheque or EFTPOS. If you do choose to pay your account by term, please note that payment must be made in the last week of the term. St Munchin's utilises the services of the Catholic Development Fund as a means of paying your school fees by direct debit.
