On Sunday, we celebrated the Feast of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church. We remember on this Feast how Jesus gave His disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit so they would know that He was still with them and would give them the courage to live as Christians in the world. Because of the Holy Spirit, the disciples knew that Jesus was not gone and God was not distant. The Spirit was the presence of Jesus, the restless urge to life in the disciples who empowered each one of them to continue Jesus' mission to live as the love and presence of God in the world. The disciples handed on the stories of Jesus' life and helped to spread the Catholic faith throughout the world.




The Faction Cross Country Carnival will be held on Wednesday 26th June from 9:00am.
