

St Munchin's Code of Conduct Parent and Visitors

Overview

The St Munchin's Code of Conduct establishes the minimum standard of conduct in all behaviour and decision-making to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all members of our school community. The Code of Conduct also shows us how, as a community our behaviours are a collective work that each day builds social justice into the life of our school community. Pope Francis insists that "true social justice is impossible if the human person is not the centre of concern".

Principles

- The Code of Conduct unites staff, students, parents, regular volunteers, visitors, and other community members in defining, modelling, and promoting the safety and wellbeing of students and all members of the community.
- The Code of Conduct requires that each individual respects the dignity of each person and is sensitive to the fact that each individual has emotions, hopes, fears and innate goodness which flows from being created in the image and likeness of God.
- The Code of Conduct defines the behaviours of healthy, respectful relationships that are expressed in Gospel values and modelled by all members of the community through our commitment to the common good.
- The Code of Conduct creates an environment at our school that eliminates the opportunities for abuse to occur.
- The Code of Conduct is a commitment to accept the responsibility for any action at a personal level.
